- 1. The Cocktails for a Cause competition is open to any restaurant, bar, distillery, vineyard or brewery in the surrounding (Southbury) area who currently holds a valid liquor license in the State of Connecticut.
- 2. Each participating establishment must use the official entry form.
- 3. Cocktails will be judged only on taste, presentation and creativity.
- 4. You will be responsible for all ingredients (including ice) and equipment needed to prepare your cocktail. If power is required, make sure to bring an extension cord/power strip and tape to secure them.
- 5. Each establishment will be provided one table and two chairs for the event. Set up times TBD
- 6. Each establishment will be responsible for providing 1 oz martini samples to all attendees 21 +
- 7. We will provide you with 1 oz. tasting cups, cocktail napkins and table linens. We will supply a framed sign with your Venue Name and Drink Name for the table. Please bring: garbage bags and any other items you may need to set and break down. Feel free to bring business cards.
- 8. This event is 21+ ONLY. There are no exceptions.
- 9. Deadline for participation and paperwork is February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- 10. Please email a jpeg file of your establishment's logo (to Avrilfis@gmail.com) be used for advising and social media coverage leading up to event. Deadline is February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- 11. You may not change your cocktail entry after March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.
